<u>Notice to Buyers</u> – Terms of sale – **All purchased to be settled for and cleared on day of sale.** Purchase notes and delivery orders will be obtained from the sales cashier when the lots are settled for and, on handing delivery orders to shepherds in charge, they will give delivery and assist in trucking. The correct numbers of each lot will be given at the time of sale. When lots require to be cut the auctioneers reserve the right to send their yard shepherd to do so. Payment will only be taken in cash, cheque or debit card which will be subject to a surcharge as detailed below. Disputed sturdy sheep shall be decided by the yard shepherd. Every assistance in trucking will be arranged, as far as possible by the auctioneers who will not be responsible for loss or damage incurred thereby. Full trucking instructions including postal address must be left in writing with the office.

<u>Notice to Consigners</u> – The shepherds and herds in charge must remain beside their respective lots and take them to the sale ring. Should the shepherd not be in attendance at the time his lots fall to be sold it may be passed over and taken at the end of the sale. The Auctioneers will in no way be responsible for lost sheep.

Food Chain Information Declarations are on the reverse of the official sheep movement licenses or alternatively, are available from the office or on the Dingwall Mart website. It is the duty of all consigners of livestock to notify auctioneers at the point of sale or any withdrawal periods which may apply to the stock they offer for sale and it is also the responsibility of the buyer to ensure that any animal destined for the food chain are outwith any withdrawal period.

<u>Sheep Tagging</u> – All sheep must be ear-tagged as per SGRPID regulations before arrival purchasers must satisfy themselves that all sheep are tagged before leaving the site. Auctioneers will not be held responsible for sheep identification once sheep have left the site.

Special Notices

Card payments for livestock purchases carry an industry standard surcharge of 1% on personal debit cards & 1.75% on business debit cards. We DO NOT accept credit card payments for livestock.

Any livestock left on the premise and/or in lairage at any point either before or after a sale is done entirely at the vendors or purchasers' own risk. No responsibility is accepted for any losses incurred.

Anyone wishing to purchase on behalf of a third party must inform the management prior to bidding. Management reserves the right to refuse to transfer any account not agreed prior to purchase. Responsibility for any transferred accounts remains with the bidder.

SHEEP IDENTIFICATION AND TRACEABILITY REQUIREMENTS DOUBLE TAGGING REQUIREMENTS FROM 31 DECEMBER 2009

<u>Movement documents</u> It is a legal requirement that all sheep must be accompanied with a properly completed and signed Scottish Government Movement Document when moving to the market to allow accurate notification of movements to SAMU

SHEEP SCAB ORDER

Any person who suspects a sheep may be infected by sheep scab must notify the DVM. Where the presence of sheep scab is suspected movement restrictions are triggered, prohibiting the movement of sheep onto or off the premises until either:

All affected sheep or carcases have been either treated or disposed of and the owner / keeper has notified the DVM, in writing, within 2 weeks of treatment including (i) the date of treatment, (ii) the number of animals treated and (iii) the treatment used.

A veterinary surgeon has notified the DVM that in their opinion there are no affected sheep or carcasses on the premises and has not been for at least 16 days.

WELFARE OF ANIMALS DURING TRANSPORT

It is an offence to transport pregnant female animals to market for sale if they have reached the latest stage of gestation (within 10% of the estimated time of the gestation before birth) and for a period of one week after giving birth.

VETERINARY MEDICAL WITHDRAWALS

Unless otherwise stated at the time of sale (either by the auctioneer, on the catalogue or the display screens) all livestock are sold as having completed all withdrawal periods for any veterinary medicines they have received. For any animals under treatment the details must be completed in the movement declaration form. It is the responsibility of the buyer to ensure that any animal destined for the food chain are outwith any withdrawal periods.
